AQUATIC SCIENCES SEASONAL TECHNICIAN II

The Jones Center at Ichauway invites applications for a full time, temporary, **Seasonal Technician II**, in the Aquatic Sciences Lab. This is a three-month temporary position that will be available February 1, 2024, with the possibility of extension.

The 28,000-acre Research Center is located approximately 30 miles south of Albany, Georgia. The Center's research, education, and conservation programs focus on ecology and natural resource management. The site includes 16,000 acres of longleaf pine forests, over 1,000 acres of wetlands, and 26 miles of stream and river ecosystems. For more information visit our website at www.jonesctr.org.

The Aquatic Sciences Lab studies freshwater quantity and quality in the lower Flint River Basin. Work subjects may include the carbon and nitrogen dynamics of isolated wetlands and the primary and secondary productivity of karst rivers.

Job requirements: The successful candidate will work both in the lab and the field, predominately the streams, rivers, lakes, and wetlands of the lower Flint River basin. Field duties will include, but not limited to, assisting with water quality sample collection and establishing and maintaining *in situ* sensor stations. The candidate may also contribute to population surveys of native mussels. Other responsibilities will include processing water samples, preparing equipment for field work, data entry, and acid washing. Experience in field biology, ecology, or environmental data collection is strongly encouraged. Applicants must have the ability to conduct moderate to strenuous physical activity in the field under demanding field conditions (i.e., heat, high humidity, and insects), swim, snorkel, and independently follow instructions. Applicants should be comfortable working out of small research boats and canoes.

Minimum qualifications: B.S. with experience in biology, ecology or related field. Experience with MS-Windows based computers. Must be able to swim.

Salary: \$14.00 per hour with housing; \$16.00 per hour with no housing.

Limited on-site housing is available.
